Community and School Involvement

- ✓ Consider number of years of commitment to an activity or organization.
- ✓ Consider leadership and special awards and honors.
- ✓ Consider awards and honors that single out only a few students for special recognition.
- ✓ Do not judge whether one activity is more worthwhile than another. Students choose to participate in activities in which they are interested or have special skills.

Score

(max. 10 points)

Financial Need

- ✓ Consider how the student plans to fund their education.
- ✓ Consider if student has applied for financial aid, grants or loans.
- ✓ Consider whether student has or will work while attending school and whether it is part-time, full-time or several jobs at once.
- ✓ Consider whether they are a single parent, have dependants or are head of a household.

Education Need

- ✓ Consider whether student is seeking a degree or certificate.
- ✓ Consider whether additional schooling will be needed after CSI.
- ✓ Consider whether student needs additional schooling for current employment.
- ✓ Consider whether student has set goals for themselves.
- ✓ Consider whether student is enrolled in other WSDA program as well as online general education courses. (additional 20 points)

Application

- ✓ Consider if the application was turned in on time or early.
- ✓ Consider the presentation of the application i.e. typewritten.
- ✓ Consider application completeness.
- ✓ Consider whether all attachments were included.
- ✓ Consider additional attachments i.e. letters of recommendation.

Academic Record

- ✓ Refer to applicants transcripts.
